- Two Problems...
  - ▶ They were driven by **formalism** .
  - ▶ They were paralyzed by **fear** .
- Two Options...
  - **Retreat** from the mission.
  - **Risk** everything for the mission.

# WILL WE EMBRACE OUR <u>COMFORT</u> OR WILL WE EMBRACE HIS <u>CROSS</u>?

- Let us go with Jesus to the...
  - **Dirty** places.
  - **Despised** places.
  - **Dangerous** places.
- Do we **really** want to be where Jesus is?
- Mission without suffering is Christianity without <u>a cross</u>.
- Suffering is not a consequence of our mission; it is the central strategy for achieving our mission.
