Five Reasons Why The Word Of God Must Be Central In Our Worship...

■ Because of the Word's <u>magnitude</u>.

- Remember the **significance** of God's revelation.
 - God reveals Himself <u>as</u> the Word.
 - God reveals Himself <u>through</u> the Word.
- Remember the **seriousness** of man's proclamation.
 - The preacher <u>exposes</u> the voice of God.
 - The preacher **exalts** the greatness of God.

Because of the Word's <u>authority</u>.

- Apart from the Word, the **preacher** is helpless.
- Apart from the Word, the **church** is powerless.

■ Because of the Word's relevance.

- ▶ The Word speaks to contemporary **needs**.
- ▶ The Word speaks about eternal **promises**.
 - Prosperity and **success** (Joshua 1:8-9)
 - Converts our souls, makes us wise, gives joy to our hearts, enlightens our eyes (Psalm 19:7-11)
 - Everlasting, true, righteous, invaluable, sweet to the taste (Psalm 19:7-11)
 - Guidance and **directions** for the future (Psalm 119:105)
 - **Comfort** and strength in our struggles (Isaiah 40:1-31)
 - Reveals Jesus Himself (John 1:1-14)
 - Truth and holiness (John 17:17)
 - Results in faith for salvation (Romans 10:17)
 - **Peace** amidst anxiety (Philippians 4:4-7)
 - Wisdom for salvation, teaching, rebuke, correction, instruction, <u>matures</u> and prepares us to serve God (2 Timothy 3:14-17)
 - Spiritual nourishment (1 Peter 2:2)
- Why would we want to **listen to** anything else?

(Over)

■ Because of the Word's <u>purpose</u>.


- ▶ God's agenda in Scripture:
 - To show us the **glory** of Christ.
 - To transform us into the <u>image</u> of Christ.
- ➤ The focus in our worship: good stuff or God's stuff?

When we focus on good stuff instead of God's stuff...

- We rob ourselves of the **truth** that is necessary for realizing God's purpose in our lives.
- We rob **God** of the glory that is due His name.

When we focus on God's stuff instead of good stuff...

- We fill ourselves with the truth that is necessary for realizing God's purpose in our lives.
- We glorify God by <u>becoming</u> like Christ.



Because of the Word's effect.

- ▶ The Word awakens **conviction**.
- ▶ The Word leads to **conversion**.
- The Word results in continuation.

The Bottom Line...

Our effectiveness as a church is completely dependent on our <u>faithfulness</u> to God's Word.
