


The Christian Life...

CHRIST

- The empowered life.
 - He is the **image** of God.
 - He is the **author** of creation.
 - He is the **head** of the church.
 - He is the <u>Savior</u> of the world.

IN


- The <u>transformed</u> life.
 - Jesus died <u>for</u> you so that He might live in you.
 - Authentic spiritual transformation happens from the inside out.



- Jesus has no desire to <u>improve</u> you; He desires to transform you.
- Christianity is nothing less than the outliving of the **indwelling** Christ.

YOU

The exchanged life.



- Jesus has exchanged His life **for** us.
- To fulfill His mission **through** us.
 - Christ suffered to accomplish salvation; we suffer to spread salvation.
 - Will we embrace the cross of Christ so that they might enjoy the Christ of the cross?

THE HOPE

- The secured life.
 - Christ is in **you**.
 - You are in **Christ**.
 - Christ is in **God**.

OF GLORY

- The <u>completed</u> life.
 - Christ in you <u>now</u> means Christ in you <u>forever</u>.
