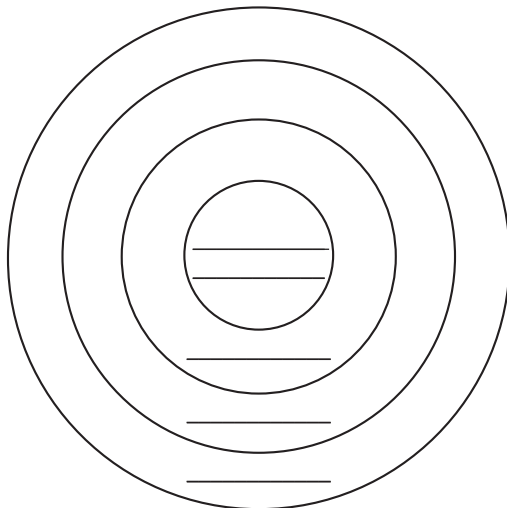

One Obvious Conclusion...

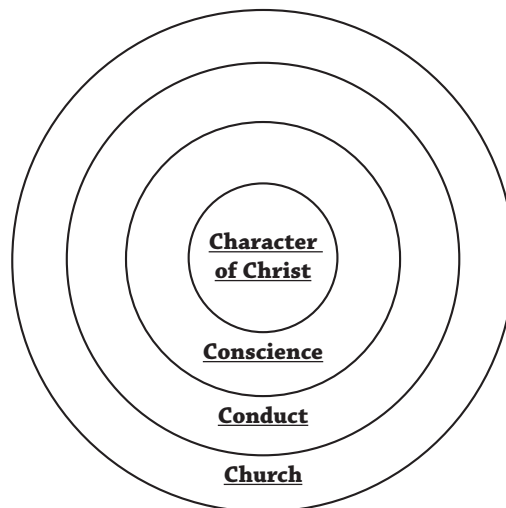
- Disciple-making revolves around the **Word** of God.
