Acts 13:13 - 52

WHO JESUS IS . . .

1 - Jesus is the center of all history.

Acts 13:16

"... Men of Israel and you who fear God, listen. The God of this people Israel ..."

Acts 13:23

"Of this man's offspring [of David's offspring] God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus."

WHO JESUS IS . . .

2 – Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promises.

Acts 13:23

"Of this man's offspring God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus, as he promised."

Acts 13:27

"... understand the utterances of the prophets, which are read every Sabbath ..."

Acts 13:29, 32

"... all that was written of him ... we bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, this he has fulfilled ..."

WHAT JESUS DID . . .

- 1 Jesus died on a cross as our Savior.
- 2 Jesus rose from the dead as our King.

Acts 13:29 - 30

"They took him down from the tree and laid him in a tomb. But God raised him from the dead . . ."

Acts 13:32 - 34

"What God promised to the fathers, this he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus . . . He raised him from the dead, no more to return to corruption . . ."

Acts 13:36

"David . . . served the purpose of God in his own generation, fell asleep and was laid with his fathers and saw corruption

. . . "

Acts 13:38 - 39

"Let it be known to you therefore, brothers, that through this man forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you . . . and by him everyone who believes is freed from everything from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses."

1 - Everyone who follows Jesus is forgiven and free.

WHAT THIS MEANS . . .

2 - Everyone who forsakes Jesus will be condemned forever.

Acts 13:46

"... judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life ..."

HOW WE LIVE . . .

1 - We sacrifice our lives proclaiming Jesus for the joy of all people.

Acts 13:48

"... when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord."

HOW WE LIVE . . .

2 - We sacrifice our lives obeying Jesus with joy as His people.

Acts 13:52

"... the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit."
